RE: Standard Revision on coat color and eye color

The BCA National Council approved a Standard Revision on coat color and patterns and eye color at the 2015 National Council meeting in Cromwell, Connecticut. The revision is to clarify and correct Bulldog coat colors and patterns and to make <u>non-Standard coat colors and eye colors a Disqualification</u>. The ONLY Council-approved changes to the Bulldog Standard are regarding coat and eye color. No other changes were approved.

A Standard Revision request has already been submitted to AKC, and upon their approval, the revision will be put to the BCA membership for a vote. For the Standard Revision to be implemented, we need a 2/3 majority vote of the membership respondents in favor of this revision.

The attached power point presentation was prepared to help you educate members on the non-Standard color problem in Bulldogs, explains the reasons why a Standard Revision is necessary, and provides the exact verbiage of the Standard Revision.

To assist us in getting the word out on the importance of this upcoming vote, please use the power point presentation as an educational tool at upcoming club and division meetings, and distribute directly to your members. **We anticipate** a response from AKC soon, so please use and distribute as soon as possible.
